### ST. ANDREWS' CHURCH MAGHULL TOWER BELLS.

I am very pleased announce that the overhaul of the Tower Bells has been completed almost 12 months ahead of the planned date. This has been made possible by the fantastic response of many people and organisations who have donated to the target of £8,254.00. My sincere thanks go to all who donated so generously. A list of the donors will be displayed in the base of the tower adjacent to the plaque of the bells donor, John Pimbley. **It is planned to have a "Celebration" on THURSDAY 17th MAY 2018** which is the Centenary of the installation and dedication of the bells by the Lord Bishop of Liverpool. Regular ringing at the principal Sunday service will commence on 9th July and at weddings and other special occasions. To enable this to happen, we need some new ringers! Anyone interested in joining the team will be very welcome. No previous experience is necessary, and training will be given. There are 15 spiral steps up to the ringing chamber.
