A list of the donors will be displayed in the base of the tower adjacent to the plaque of the bells donor, John Pimbley. **It is planned to have a "Celebration" on THURSDAY 17th MAY 2018** which is the Centenary of the installation and dedication of the bells by the Lord Bishop of Liverpool. Regular ringing at the principal Sunday service will commence on 9th July and at weddings and other special occasions. To enable this to happen, we need some new ringers!
